@ Carpet Pub Crawl

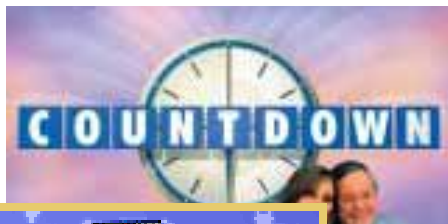
At the beginning we were nervous of our carpets and about being embarrassed, but after a few drinks everyone relaxed and the fun started!
